Basketball Rules

1. Good sportsmanship (includes players, coaches and parents), no abusive language, mannerisms, etc.
2. Attendance to church, Sunday school or altar on game days is mandatory! Any exceptions to this rule must be discussed with Father Peter Stratos in advance.

OFFICIAL CODE OF CONDUCT

(GOBL) Greek Orthodox Basketball League

- 1. All coaches, players and advisors shall maintain appropriate composure of themselves, their teams and the crowd. Failure to do so will call for a Technical Foul by the official, disciplinary action by the home community, GOBL Sponsor, and Priest. Each parish shall maintain proper decorum from their fans before, during and after all games at all times
- 2. Any player, coach, parent or fan who verbally abuses a Priest, Referee, Commissioner or Representative will be barred from participation for the remainder of the season and playoffs.
- 3. Any player, coach, parent or fan that starts or participates in a fight before, during, or after a GOBL game will be disqualified for the remainder of the season and playoffs.
- 4. No defacing or destruction of any property (be it public or private restrooms, walls, window, floors, cars, etc. shall be allowed. A fine to the community will be implemented to reimburse costs for damages in the event of vandalism.
 - A. No athlete, coach or fan shall use abusive language, profanity, or make obscene gestures on or off the court at anytime. This includes before or after all game& after one warning, such behavior will result in league suspension.
 - B. No athlete, coach, representative or fan shall attempt to goad, needle, provoke, or verbally ignite another person into a tight (righting to protect yourself is not the same as provoking a fight), This will result in a league suspension.
 - C. Any personnel on the team bench who conducts themselves in any unsportsmanlike conduct (including any of the above) shall be punished accordingly.

PENALTIES

- 1. When an official hears or sees any of the preceding he must give a Technical Foul, remove the offender from the game and/or the stadium for the flagrant action.
- 2. When a coach hears or sees any of the preceding, he/she must remove any offenders from the game and or stadium. If the offender’s actions weren’t flagrant, or the player was not disqualified, he may return to the game as soon as the coach feels the athlete is calm enough to keep proper composure.

Liability Waiver and Acknowledgment of Responsibility Form - 2012

Please Read, Fill Out, and Bring signed form to Participate

By attending and/or participating in the **Greek Orthodox Basketball League (“GOBL”)**, the participant named below (and his or her parent or legal guardian on his or her behalf) hereby releases and forever discharges the GOBL, all participating churches, sponsors of the events and activities of the GOBL, owners and operators of any site on which GOBL games are played or events sponsored, and their respective officers, members, owners, employees, agents, representatives, independent contractors, and affiliated persons and entities (collectively, the “Released Persons”) from any and all liabilities and claims of any kind (including without limitation personal injury, property damage or death), which the participant or his or her legal representatives, has or may in the future have, whether known or unknown, arising out of that participant’s attendance at or participation in the GOBL (collectively, the “Released Claims”).

This Release is binding even if the risks and liabilities being released arise out of the negligence or carelessness of one or more of the Released Persons. This Release is binding on the participant’s legal representatives, heirs and assigns.

Each person signing this Release acknowledges the possibility that the participant and/or his or her legal representatives may not fully know the number or magnitude of all the Released Claims, but nevertheless intends to assume the risk of the participant attending and/or participating in the GOBL.

Further, each person signing this release, acknowledges that the participant and/or his or her legal guardian shall be fully responsible for any personal injury, and/or physical damage caused by the participant during his or her participation in the GOBL sponsored events and shall hold the GOBL and all participating churches harmless there from.

If a participant is under 18 years old, this release must be signed by the participant’s parent or legal guardian.* Participant agrees to abide by and accept the terms set out on signs on various GOBL activities.
